One of the most prolific and influential artists of the twentieth century, American photographer Robert Mapplethorpe, the master of art photography, famed for his highly controversial and sexually explicit images, radically changed the preconceptions of medium and stretched its boundaries, both in themes and style. Mapplethorpe's diverse body of work, includes portraiture and still life photographs of flowers, but is widely recognized for his dark and decadent photographs of erotic imagery.

In 1989, the year he succumbed to AIDS, the Corcoran Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C., canceled an exhibition of Mapplethorpe's work that included photographs of anal-fisting and naked children. Three decades later, he's the subject of "Implicit Tensions," a two-part retrospective at the Guggenheim , and Mapplethorpe (2019), a creatively-named biopic starring Matt Smith from Doctor Who .
